The Lenten season began on Wednesday February 26th with distribution of Ashes reminding us of our need to repent and believe in the Gospel. During the next few weeks of Lent, your child along with our parish family, those in our RCIC and RCIA who are preparing to receive the Sacraments of Initiation into full communion with the Catholic Church and the entire Church throughout the world will be entering into a more intentional and spiritual journey in preparation for the great Feast of the Resurrection of the Lord. Through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving during these weeks, may our faith grow stronger by increasing our love for God and others, stretching our hearts to be more charitable, and making our celebration of Easter especially meaningful.
